1. Principal's Report

- It is incredible how quickly the first semester has passed! We have been working diligently to keep our staff and students safe and are very appreciative of how hard everyone is working! Unfortunately, we have several students and staff that are self-isolating due to close contacts and one class that has self-isolated due to a close contact linked to our school. The electrostatic sprayer arrived last Friday and is being used with a cleaning ingredient called VitalOxide to sanitize equipment and classrooms.
- We have increased Ashley Korogonas to a 0.5 FTE and she will be teaching mathematics to the grade 5 students in Mrs. Kongsrud's class daily.
- Laurissa Orich and Megan MacIntyre will be joining the JES staff to provide lunch and classroom supports.
- Lalilo programming will be used with students in Kindergarten to grade two. This is a phonics, word recognition, and comprehension program that can be used at home and at school.
