Trustee Report

Dale reported the School Board met discussing 1) district re-entry plans and 2) a focus on literacy. The Re-entry plan changed as the mask mandate was instituted by the Provincial Government. The Board has contracted literacy consultants. Teachers in the district will have access to these consultants.

Eric stated 50/50 split, parents who use the lunch program and those who do not. There needs to be a discussion regarding options, as the current model is not working.
